## Tags

Based on a user's selection in a request form, you can set up the system to automatically apply [relevant tags](https://lytho.knowledgeowl.com/help/managing-tags) (<https://lytho.knowledgeowl.com/help/managing-tags>) to the request form and associated work item. This automates the process of adding tags, making it easier to search or filter your account for certain work along the way. For example, if a requester selects an option for a "Brochure," you could have the system apply the **PRINT** tag to the request and associated work item, making it easy to find among other print projects in the future.
