



#### **Password Management**


Now admin users can set requirements to ensure user passwords meet expected security thresholds. Options include setting expiration periods, minimum length requirements, and requiring the inclusion of a number, special character, and uppercase letters. #### **Updated Work List Views**




Now Filter By Stage & Year



A new filter, "Project Status Stage," is now available in All Work, Tasks, Proofs, and Projects reports and custom views. This will allow users to aggregate all projects in the "To Do," "In Progress," and "Completed" stages, regardless of specific status within those stages.



Date filters on all reports and custom views now include the option "This Year" making it even easier to view information most relevant to your needs.




More Automation with Auto-Naming!





# **Additional Improvements:**

People now displays users in a list, making it easier to view full user details

When searching in ignite, users now have the option of clicking a search button to initiate the search, in addition to pressing "Enter" on their keyboard



User import has increased from 100 to 500 users at a time
