Transcript

You've created a **barcode**, but now you want to make this as a variable for your end user to update the URL.

I've got my barcode added.

You can see under the **barcode tab** all of the settings

I'm going to go to the **variable data tab** to add a variable.

I am going to name this QR code, and then the type should be **short text**.

If I were to go back to my barcode, there's now a variable dropdown here

I am going to select the **QR code** and apply.

You'll notice that it is now saying that there's no input data.

If I were to go to my **variables tab** on the left under, under QR code, I could set what that variable should be knowing that my end user will change this once they get into **Tempo**.
